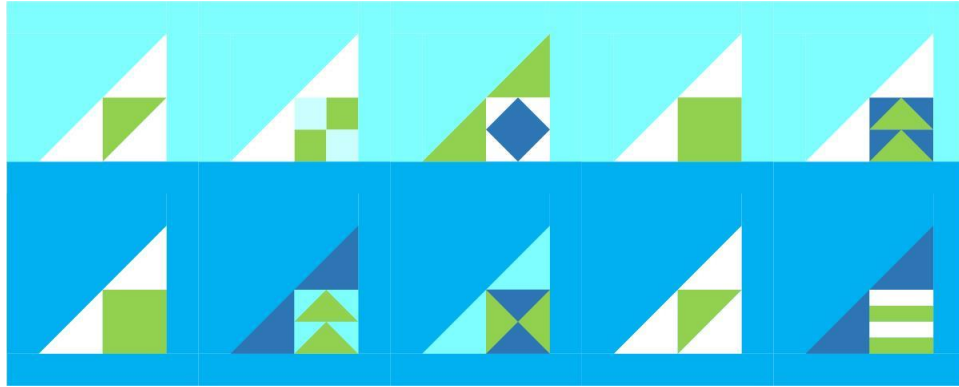

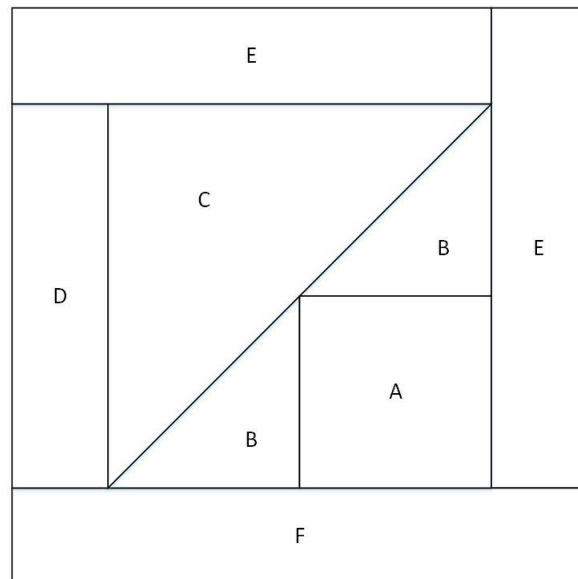






This block is inspired by the sailboats on Lake Union in Seattle, Washington and gives you plenty of opportunity to play and customize. Have fun making your own fleet of quilty sailboats.

Any 4-inch finished block can be used for Patch A. A few suggestions are included.



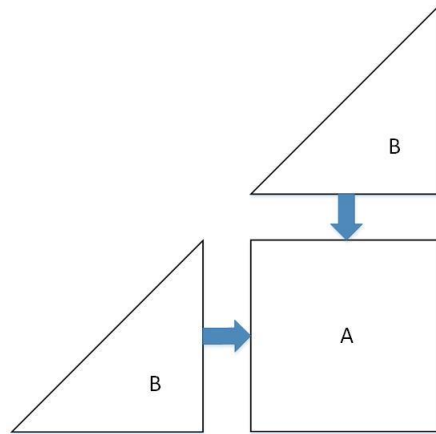
Cutting Chart	
Patch	Cutting Directions
A	See A Patch Options (below)
B	One 4 7/8-inch x 4 7/8-inch square. Cut in half on diagonal to yield 2 half square triangles

C	One 8 7/8-inch x 8 7/8-inch square. Cut in half on diagonal to yield 2 half square triangles. You will have one extra
D	One 2 1/2-inch x 8 1/2-inch rectangle
E	Two 2 1/2-inch x 10 1/2-inch rectangle
F	One 2 1/2-inch x 12 1/2-inch rectangle

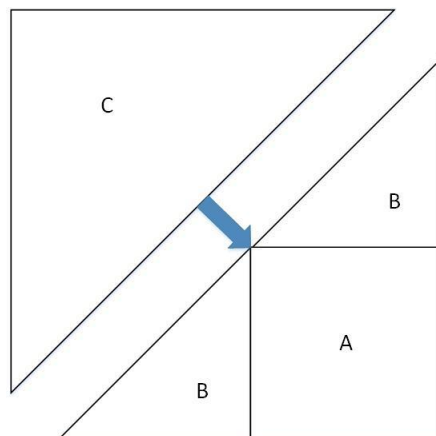
Patch A Options	
Option	Cutting Directions
Square 	Cut one 4 1/2-inch x 4 1/2-inch square. This would be a fun place to feature a favorite print
Half Square Triangle (HST) 	Cut two 4 7/8-inch x 4 7/8-inch squares from two colors. Cut each square in half diagonally. Sew triangles of different colors together (RST) on diagonal edge. You will have an extra square for another Regatta block OR Cut two 5-inch x 5-inch squares of two fabrics. Draw diagonal line on one fabric. Place squares RST. Sew 1/4-inch from both sides of the drawn diagonal line. Cut on the diagonal line. Press block open. Align 45 degree line on ruler to diagonal seam and position ruler so you can cut a 4-1/2 x 4-1/2 square. Trim two sides. Reorient ruler to trim remaining two untrimmed sides. Yield: two 4 1/2-inch HSTs. You will have one extra to make another Regatta block.
4 patch 	Cut four 2 1/2-inch x 2 1/2-inch squares. Use 2 to 4 colors. Arrange as desired. Sew patches together
Stripe 	Cut four 1 1/2-inch x 4 1/2-inch strips from 2 to 4 colors. Arrange as desired. Sew together along long edges
Hour Glass 	Cut two 5 1/2-inch squares from two different colors. Cut each square twice diagonally to yield 4 quarter-square triangles. Arrange in hour glass pattern and sew patches together. Yield: two 4 1/2-inch hour glass blocks. You will have one extra to make another Regatta block.
Improv stripe	Create strata from random width strips until strata is at least 4 1/2-inch x 4 1/2-inch. Trim to 4 1/2-inch x 4 1/2-inch

Piecing Instructions

1. Make one Patch A. Patch A should measure 4 ½-inch x 4 ½-inch, including seam allowances
2. Sew one Patch B to Patch A. Add second Patch B



3. Sew Patch C half square triangle (HST). Your block should now measure 8 ½-inch x 8 ½-inch square, including seam allowances



4. Sew Patches D, E (2), and F as shown. Tada! You're done
